- » Essay required.

Write an essay of 1000 words or less, or submit a video no less than five minutes but no more than 10 minutes that address the following questions...

- » What do you want to do after you graduate from college?
- » Why did you select this career?
- » How will you change the field/industry?
- » Where do you see yourself 10 years from now?
- » How will you make a difference in our world?
- » How have you made a difference in your community?
- » Describe a meaningful volunteer experience?
